Revocation-Upon-Divorce Statute Applies to Life Policy

"A decedent's mother was entitled to the proceeds of his life insurance policy even though his exwife was the named beneficiary at the time of his death, a Superior Court judge has ruled. After the insurer filed an interpleader action concerning the policy's proceeds, decedent Sean Parker's mother, Joann Parker, filed a cross-claim against Sean's ex-wife, Dawn Diana-Parker, seeking the benefits pursuant to the revocation-upon-divorce provision in the Massachusetts Uniform Probate Code, G.L.c. 190B, §2-804(b)(1)."
